At greeNest, we know that a home is more than four walls. It is a place of dignity, comfort, and possibility. Because of your generosity, children have proper beds and desks, families gather around dining tables, and empty spaces become welcoming homes. These simple furnishings create powerful moments of connection, stability, and hope. This past year, we made thoughtful enhancements that allowed us to serve more families than ever before, even as the need in our community continues to grow.

In 2025, we proudly celebrated greeNest's 10th anniversary, a milestone that honors a decade of care, compassion, and collaboration. greeNest was also the proud recipient of the Premier Cares Award. In the fall, we hosted our inaugural givingRooms event, a vibrant and inspiring success that expanded our supporter network and strengthened our community of champions committed to our mission.

To date, greeNest has provided new beds to 3,368 children through our Up Off The Floor program and furnished the homes of 2,409 families through our Finally Home program. This impact is made possible by more than 120 partner agencies, over 190 dedicated volunteers, and generous donors like you.



